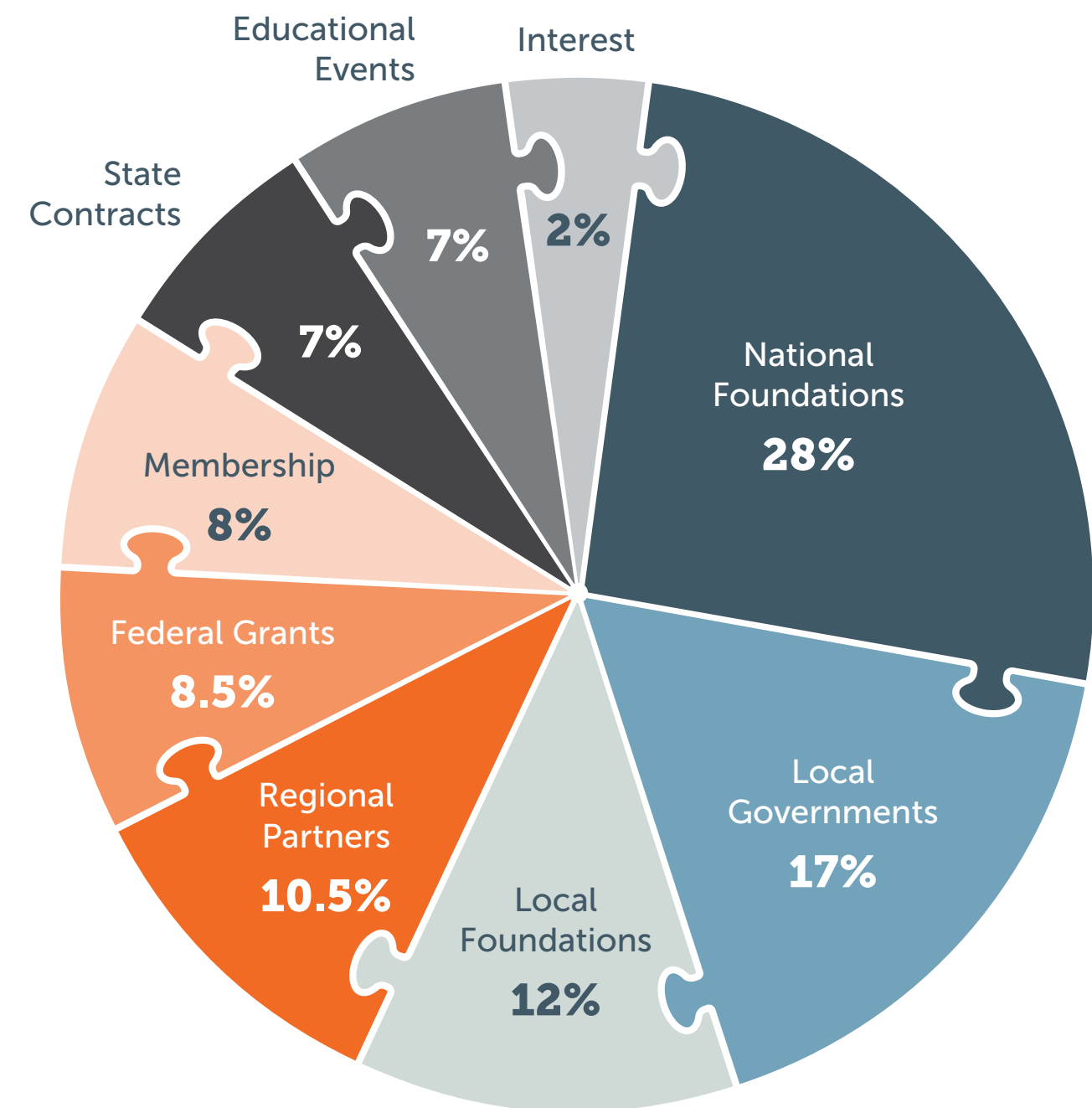

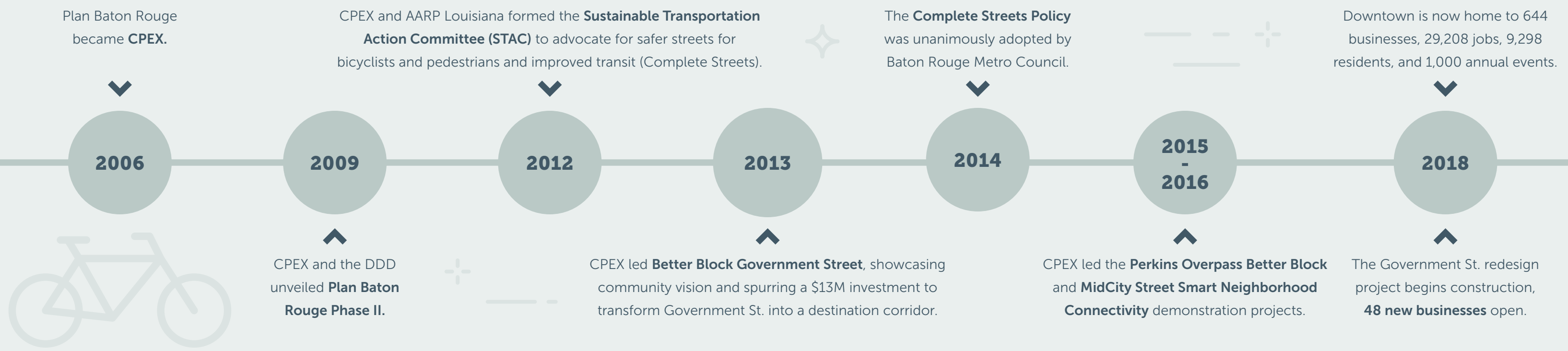

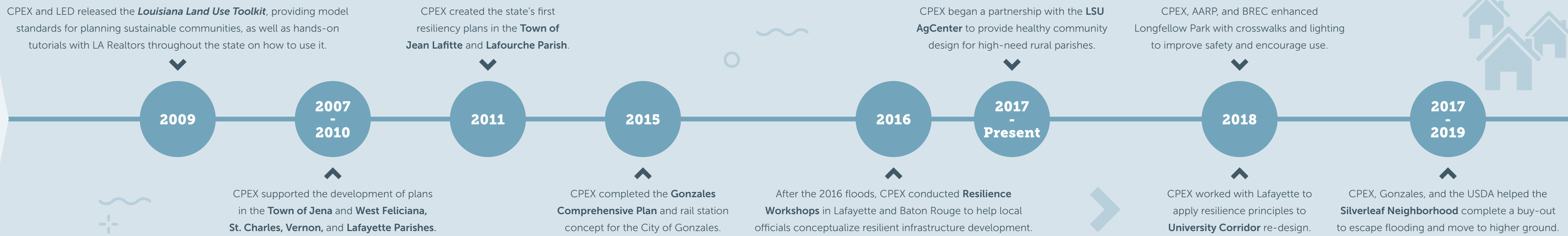
1998 PLANNING FOR BATON ROUGE

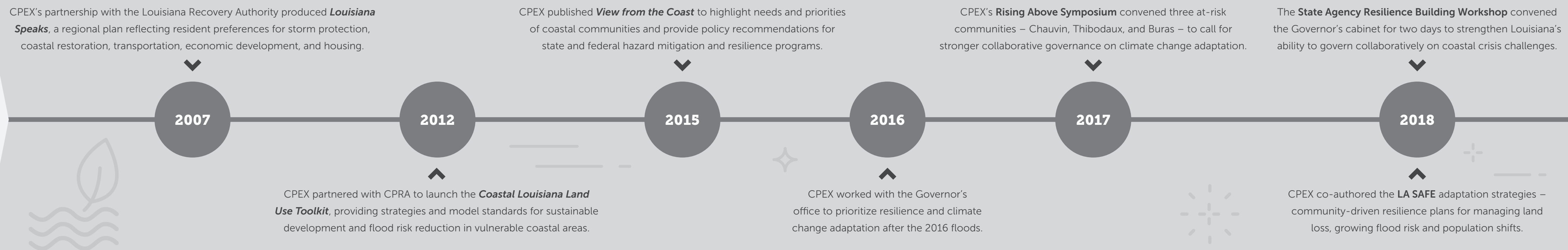
2006 PLANNING FOR LA COMMUNITIES
